

Shepherd ISD Volunteer Dress Code

All volunteers will maintain a professional appearance which is appropriate for the professional environment and functions.

To appear professional:

- Clothing should be pressed and not wrinkled.
- Leggings may be worn but your top must not be shorter than 5 inches above the knee.
- **NO** transparent clothing
- Clothing should be of proper length, no shorter than 2 inches above the knee
- Clothing is not too tight or too loose, revealing, sagging or too short.
- Warm-up/wind suits or pants are not to be worn, with the exception of physical education events.
- Hair should be kept clean and well groomed. Hair must be clean, neat and out of the eyes. Men's hair will not exceed the collar line. Men will not wear ponytails, rattails or any type of hairstyle that is disruptive to the educational process.
- Mustaches and sideburns must be kept clean, neatly trimmed and not to exceed past the lobe of the ear. Facial hair must be trimmed and groomed.
- **ALL** tattoos must be covered while at school and any school related event to which you are volunteering.
- **NO** body jewelry, with the exception of female earlobes, is allowed at school or school related events to which you are volunteering.
- **NO** flip flops are allowed
- T-shirts may be worn (**NO** inappropriate wording or symbols)
- Jeans may be worn
 - Must be neat and professional in appearance
 - Not be old or worn out
 - Not be frayed
 - Be without holes
 - Be loose fitting
